

**GUIDANCE NOTES FOR BERTH ALLOCATION**

- No boats to be stored on the Car Park, unless approved by Council beforehand.
- No boats to be stored on grass in front of club house, or on designated Windsurf Rigging areas.
- Refer to Byelaws: 17 / 22 / 23 / 24 / 25 / 27
- Boat berths in designated area as specified by council. There are currently 4 rows of berths A to D, in addition, if this area becomes full, the site of the old clubhouse can be utilised. Council will decide when to open this area.
- Responsibility of Tying down of boats lies with the owner.
- Trip hazards from stakes etc must be minimised.
- Berth holder must maintain berth in a tidy manner
- Appropriate berth fees must be paid and maintained to allow occupancy of a berth
- Berth positions are not guaranteed year on year.
- Berths are not allocated for boat storage; it is expected all boats will sail at least once per year to be allowed continued use of the dinghy park
- Berths will be allocated using the following guidelines with regards choice of position
  - Disabled sailor, who sails >13 times per annum
  - Any Sailor, who sails > 13 times per annum
  - Disabled sailor, who sails > 5 times per annum
  - Any Sailor, who sails >5 times per annum
- Road trailers must not be kept under craft and should be stored in the designated trailer area. They must be identifiable. Council reserve the right to dispose of unidentified trailers.
- Boats occupying prime positions, that are not regularly sailed (See criteria above) may be reallocated a berth
- A record of boat berths / class of boat / member will be displayed in the club house
- Berth sizes:
  - Larger Dinghies – 4.8 x 2.2 mtrs
  - Smaller Dinghies – 3.6 x 1.8 mtrs
