

COUNCIL FEE PROPOSALS – AGM 2025

2025-26 SUBSCRIPTIONS

In response to the cost-of-living increases in recent years Council is looking to increase subscription income by around 20%. These increases will be introduced in three phases over subscription years 2024 to 2027. Each phase will include a revision to the Family Membership to reflect the changing demographic of the Club and the changing make up of families joining.

Following discussions at the Sept Council meeting it is proposed the fees for the 25-26 subscription year shall be as follows:

REVIEW OF PROPOSALS

These proposals implement a revision of the concession provided for Family Member Groups by limiting the number of included children/grandchildren and calculating the fee by applying one adult member, three quarters adult member and two half Junior member fees. It is expected that this concession will be adjusted further in later years.

Applying these proposals provides a better balance between the various membership options, reflecting changes in the club's demographic. The increased fees will provide the assessed increases in income to cover rising costs incurred in the last two years. In addition, the club will need to focus on other forms of income and additional membership to keep the club viable.
